

プリンス・オブ・ソンクラー大学パッタニー校

日本語主専攻課程第一期卒業生の動向

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PSUパッタニーの日本語主専攻課程の第一期卒業生の動向を調査した。結果、卒業後半年から1年の間に8割の学生が就職先や進学先が決定しており、過半数の卒業生が日本と何らかの接点を持ち続け日本語を日常的に使用していることが判明した。また日本語能力の自己評価では、強みとして読む、書く、話す、聞く、書く能力は万遍なく挙げられたが、弱点としては、話す、または書く能力を挙げた学生が多かった。学生生活に関しては、良かった点として友人や教師との関係を挙げたものは多かったが、カリキュラムや施設を挙げた学生は少なかった。またほとんどの卒業生が仕事や学業において英語の必要性を感じている。

The first graduating class of the Japanese language programme at PSU Pattani: employment status and level of Japanese usage

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This survey was conducted to collect referable data to improve the curriculum of the Japanese language program, and provide guidance to current and prospective students at PSU. Nearly 80% of the graduates are engaged in either full-time employment or continuing education. Many graduates are engaged in pursuits related to Japan, and more than half of them use Japanese on a daily basis. Their confidence in their language ability varies, but many of them reported a relative lack of confidence in speaking and writing. Looking back, the students were happy about their relationships with friends and teachers at PSU. Many of them were positive about their learning experience at PSU, but some were critical of the curriculum and facilities. Most appreciate the importance of English as well as Japanese in their work or studies.
